The Community Engagement Coordinator is expected to engage the public daily as a face and voice of Habitat for Humanity Cornwall & The Counties.

This is an opportunity to make a real difference and impact in our community, while working with an amazing group of professionals and an enthusiastic team. - Coordinate Events: Organize and manage outreach events, workshops, and informational sessions to raise awareness about our programs and services
- Community Impact: Deliver impactful presentations to community groups
- Content Creation: Collaborate with the team to develop compelling brand compliant content for social media platforms and promotional materials
- Offer support to home build program. ReStore and other departments when required
- Ensure effective communication between staff, volunteers and management including briefings and staff meetings
- All other duties as assigned

- Minimum 2-years' experience in a related field, nonprofit environment
- Proven track record of raising funds and organizational awareness
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills with the ability to build rapport with diverse stakeholders
